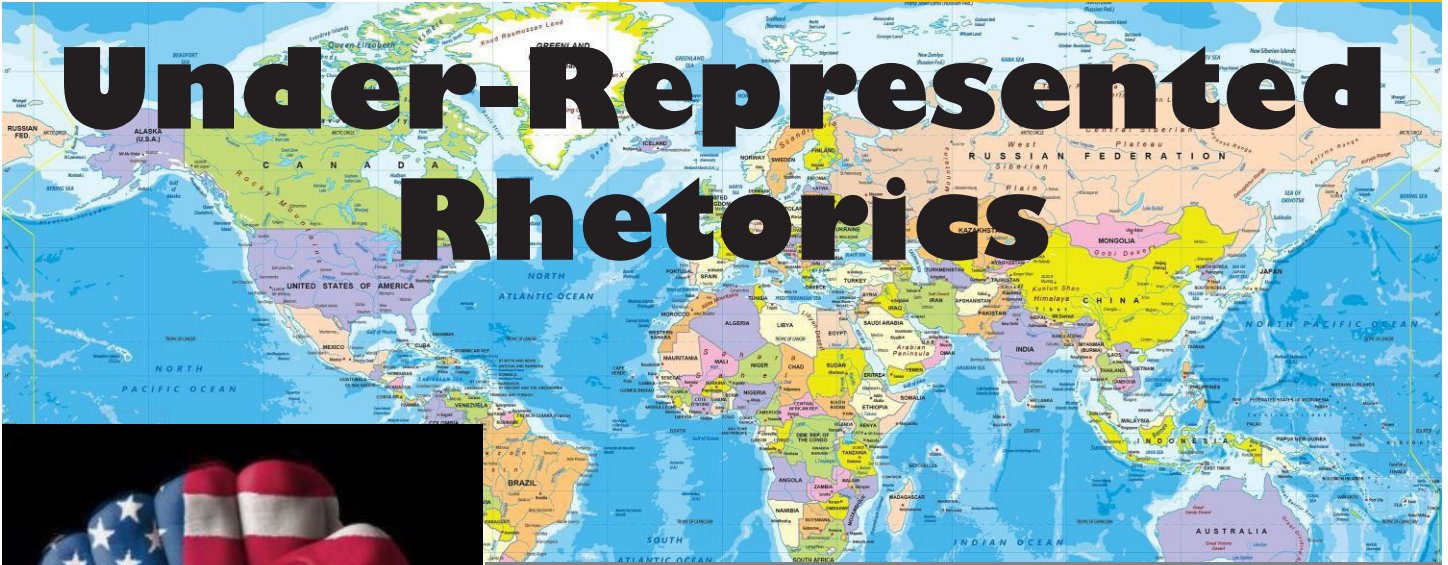


# Under-Represented Rhetorics

This course examines the discourses of power within the United States, considering the ways writing serves as a medium of control over **national** ideas and group **identities**. Simultaneously, this course explores the rhetoric representative of several national histories, heritages, and **social movements**. This course also focuses on theories of **rhetoric** and **discourse**, writing to establish the other, writing and the construction of **race**, rhetorical concepts of **gender** and **class**, and tools for analyzing **power** discourses.

Students strongly advised to take WRTG 2010 or equivalent prior to this course.
